INTERACTIVE MODEL DEMONSTRATIONS

There are 10 stations (4 participants/ station) designed to demonstrate important mechanical and clinical principles that are essential to the understanding and planning for limb deformity correction. We will try to ensure a "trainer: trainee ratio" of either 1:1 or 1:2 to ensure full understanding of the principles.









SAVBONE WORKSHOPS

We have 6 sawbone workshops that cover a range of exercises from basic to advanced procedures. Video recorded instructions will be used to allow more hands-on exercise by the participants.

- 1.Distal femur closing wedge two-plain osteotomy
- 2.Gradual correction of Ilizarov external fixator
- 3.Severe coxa vara acute correction
- 4.Unilateral femur lengthening with medial submuscular locking plate fixation
- 5.Gradual correction of Hexapod external fixator
- 6.Pelvic support osteotomy with unilateral external fixator









SMALL GROUP CASE DISCUSSIONS

• We will organise small group discussions for deformity course for the first time in 2025. Moderators will facilitate discussions on 6 selected cases that will consider various treatment options. The focus will be on indications of surgery, and tips on specific procedures.

- Distal femur medial closing wedge two-plain osteotomy
- Lateral unilateral external fixator with retrograde femur nail in-situ
- Medial submuscular locking plate fixation of femur
- Proximal tibia medial open wedge two-plain osteotomy
- Prophylactic common peroneal nerve release for bone lengthening
